### Minister of the Holy Communion

The ministry of the Ministers of Holy Communion is very important ministry in our parish community. It is closely linked to the Eucharist which is the highest and the central form of worship in our community. The guide for extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion published by Liturgical Ministry series gives us an insight how the ministry is exercised.

### What are extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist? Why are they called extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion?

Extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion is the proper term for this ministry, because the term "Eucharist Minister" can apply to the priest or deacon as well as to the Lay ministers. The term 'extraordinary' minister of Holy Communion makes it clear that they are 'extraordinary', that is out of the ordinary. While the deacon, priest and bishop are the 'ordinary' ministers of Holy Communion. It is a reminder that ministers of the Holy Communion serve in this capacity only when there is insufficient clergy to distribute Holy Communion. Additional presence of priests especially in a concelebrated mass may mean they will not be needed even though they have been rostered on to serve. This happens rarely, but it does occasionally happen. This is part of being 'extraordinary' Depending on the practise of the diocese and the parish, in the absence of a priest for Saturday night vigil Mass or Sunday Mass, the ministers of Holy Communion maybe called upon to assist or even to preside at what is commonly called a 'Communion Mass' - that is the rite of distributing Holy Communion outside mass.
