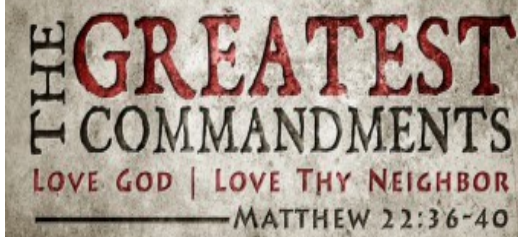
Sunday December 3: First Sunday of Advent: Lighting the Advent Wreath
