THE ROYAL COMMISSION

The Church has now been through five years of Royal Commission hearings, what has it done to ensure children are now safe in the church and that abuse survivors are now being treated fairly and with respect?

- Reviewed and changed many of the child protection and welfare policies and procedures in Church authorities;
- Increased staffing and resources for child protection activities with many dioceses and religious orders now having put in place dedicated professional standards offices to respond to complaints against people within these organisations;
- Put in place a new functionally independent company, Catholic Professional Standards, to develop, audit and report on the way in which church leaders adhere to child and vulnerable adult standards within their dioceses and religious orders;
- Put in place a new body to oversee the Church's implementation of the Royal Commission's recommendations;
- Fully supported the national redress scheme for child sexual abuse survivors so that the Church will no longer be responsible for determining compensation for abuse survivors;
- Reassessed hundreds of past abuse settlements which have been determined to be clearly inadequate – this has seen survivors receive more compensation and increased support; and
- Put in place new guidelines for the way in which Church authorities engage in civil litigation.


