Parish of Gordon Commission – update 1 July

Bishop Paul has now endorsed the approach to be undertaken by the Commission which will involve 3 distinct phases including a review of the lay led Coordinator structure, exploration of potential options for the future governance structure of the parish and discernment of a preferred structure based on a consultation process with the parish community. Parish members will have the opportunity to provide input to this three stage process in each phase. Consultation has commenced with the Parish Pastoral Council at their recent meeting, and the Commission will engage with the Finance Committee next month. A series of themes will be identified to reflect the three stages – and individuals will have the opportunity to provide input to each of the themes via forms placed at the entrance to each of our churches, with a conveniently located box for collection of completed forms. This process will commence next week-end (7-8 July) with a particular focus on what has been working well in the last 5 years. In addition email comments on each of the themes will be welcome with further details to follow.

The consultation will also involve a series of interviews and questionnaires with key personnel who have contributed to the structure over the past 5 years. The Commission will take some time to ensure that the community has time to consider

and respond to the process, with a final report to be delivered at the end of November. Sue Daly, Commission member
