THREE NEW PARISHES: Following an extensive process of consultation, Ballarat Diocese has three new parishes from groups of neighbouring parishes that were already working together. These new parishes, decreed on 1 July 2018 by Bishop Paul Bird, are St Mary MacKillop Parish, Western Border; Holy Family Parish, Northeast Mallee; and Mary Glowrey Parish, East Wimmera. The Western Border parish encompasses Casterton, Coleraine, Edenhope, Hamilton and Harrow, with Fr Paddy Mugavin as Parish Priest, Fr John Corrigan assisting and Parish Office in Hamilton. The Northeast Mallee parish incorporates Swan Hill, Sea Lake and the northern part of Quambatook parish; Fr Matthew Thomas is the Parish Priest and its Parish Office is in Swan Hill. The East Wimmera parish includes Birchip, Charlton, Donald, St Arnaud, Wycheproof and the southern part of Quambatook parish with Fr Eugene McKinnon as Parish Priest assisted by Fr Peter Jose and Parish Office in St Arnaud. Congratulations to all parishioners, parish and diocesan staff and priests involved in the development of these new parishes.

NATIONAL REDRESS SCHEME:

The Federal Government's redress scheme commenced on 1st July 2018. The Catholic Diocese of Ballarat, through the Australian Catholic Bishop's Conference, has committed to participate in the scheme as another avenue of support for people who have experienced institutional child sexual abuse.
