## **NATIONAL APOLOGY TO VICTIMS AND SURVIVORS OF INSTITUTIONAL CHILD**

**SEXUAL ABUSE:** Prime Minister Scott Morrison will deliver an apology on behalf of our nation on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> October to acknowledge and apologise for the appalling abuse endured by vulnerable children from those who were supposed to care for them, leaving immeasurable and lasting damage. The National Apology will pay tribute to victims and survivors of institutional child sexual abuse, many of whom have so bravely shared their stories through the Royal Commission into Institutional Child Sexual Abuse, with the aim of ensuring such shameful practices are never repeated. The Australian Government has requested there be no visible involvement of Institutions at this National Apology out of sensitivity to survivors. Bishop Paul will make reference to the National Apology in the next edition of Our Diocesan Community.
