THE EASTER TRIDUUM: From the time of Jesus, the Church has mourned his death and rejoiced in his resurrection. We commemorate his final days, and our Passover with him from death to life, as three intrinsically linked parts of the greatest event in history. The Mass of the Lord's Supper gathers us around the table where Jesus instituted the Eucharist and commissions us as his servants in washing his disciples' feet. Good Friday's simple, solemn liturgy begins and ends in silence as we prayerfully contemplate Jesus' suffering and death. Then our Easter Vigil and morning Masses joyfully celebrate God bringing light to where there is darkness, new life in place of death and above all Jesus' Resurrection from the dead that profoundly expresses in a way like no other God's infinite love for us then and always.

HOLY PLACES GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION: Last year Australian Catholics donated \$1.4million for the maintenance of over 70 churches and shrines associated with Jesus' life and for health, education, employment and housing assistance for Holy Land Christians who face political, religious and military challenges that are as great as ever. Our continuing generosity is greatly appreciated when we are again invited to contribute to this annual appeal on Good Friday.

PROJECT COMPASSION: Thank you to all who have supported the immense charitable work of Caritas throughout the world through your Project Compassion envelopes and boxes during Lent. We ask for final envelopes and boxes to be returned at our Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper (brought up at the Offertory) or these can be put on the collection plate on Good Friday or at Easter.
