This meeting concluded the consultation processes for the Commission and established that the communities preferred governance model involves a Lay Leadership structure with responsibility for pastoral matters managed by the Parish Pastoral Council and responsibility for financial matters managed by the

Parish Finance Committee. The structure would continue to be supported by a Supervising Priest and the parish secretary. Participants also identified key strategies for enhancing how this model works. We are now working towards a final report which will be submitted to Bishop Paul in the coming weeks.
