## Bishops Visiting Rome

Bishop Paul Bird and other Australian bishops are travelling to Rome this month to visit Pope Francis and offer a report on the state of their dioceses. The visit is referred to as *Ad Limina* (to the thresholds); the suggestion is they are visiting the tombs of the apostles, Peter and Paul. During their dialogue with Pope Francis, the Bishops will provide information and insights from their own dioceses and hear the Pope's reflections on the wider Church. The Bishops will also meet with senior workers in certain Vatican departments. The discussions will touch upon reports that each diocese has provided in preparation for the visit. We expect that Bishop Paul Bird will be in Rome from 10 June until 4 July.
