**NEW SCHOOL GOVERNANCE:** For many years our Diocese has been working towards a new way of governance for our Parish schools to better support principals and staff and most importantly the welfare and education of our children. Till now, parish priests have been the "canonical administrators" of most Parish based schools in our diocese. Some schools are owned and governed by Religious Orders with their own separate governance arrangements and will be unaffected by this change. A new Diocesan education entity has been formed, "Diocese of Ballarat Catholic Education Limited" (DOBCEL) with a Board of Directors to oversee and govern the Catholic Education Office and our Parish schools. From 1<sup>st</sup> July this will take on responsibility for several schools in our diocese where there is no priest available for the canonical administrator role. It is proposed that in time the governance of other Parish schools will also be transferred from individual priests to DOBCEL. This will be gradually done on a one by one basis after consultation with each Parish and School. When more information is received, this will be passed on so we know exactly what this change in governance will mean when in time this happens for St Augustine's School. Most likely few practical things will need changing for most of our Schools and there will be a more consistent governance and support network for Schools throughout our Diocese. This will also help the Diocese of Ballarat address Recommendation 16.6 of the recent Royal Commission that parish priests not be the employers of Catholic School principals and staff. We look forward to hearing further about this new model and discussing when may be an appropriate time for DOBCEL to take over my current canonical administrator role. Stay tuned! *Fr John Monaghan*
