## **Plenary Discussion**

After reading and discussing many crucial questions and statements made by parishioners over stage one of the Plenary Council in which 170 parishioners made their thoughts clear, the leadership team have noted that in order to be faithful to the local parish community's voice it is important to take steps to put some hopes and desires in to action where practical.

One strong theme was the need to be more welcoming and Inclusive.

This was the strongest point made in the survey and indeed over the discussion groups. This has broad implications across all ages, culture, sex, faith, disability etc. One way to begin making a difference is through a hospitality group. This need not just mean a cuppa after Mass, but searching out the hearts of others and bringing our faith community together in positive, outlooking, active, social and relaxing, prayerful ways to grow closer to each other and welcome all. You will have more ideas.

There are of course wonderful things happening in our parish, some of which we need to know more about and some which need renewal.
