Overall the risks to child safety are limited. The Parish is managed by a Parish Pastoral Council and a Parish Finance Committee.

Victorian Child Safety Standards (the Standards)

The Standards have been largely implemented.

Steps taken to implement the Standards are as follows:

- . Ruth Hoffmann has been appointed
- . There is a Parish Child Safety policy
- . There is a Parish Child Safety Code of Conduct
- . There is a Commitment to Child Safety document

Working with Children Check

We spent some time examining the register to gain an understanding the roles of those who have a WWCC.

Action: The following matters require attention:

- . The Parish could update its register of volunteers and specify their roles. As discussed above, this will help in deciding who requires a WWCC and/or Police check.

Developing a Culture of Safety

Online learning. The Parish has done an excellent job in relation to the online learning module. Fr Neville has completed an online learning module.

Training: Apart from the online training module Ruth Hoffmann and Anne McMeel have completed NCCA Safe Church Awareness training in 2019

Action: Consideration is to be given to others leaders in the Parish undertaking National Council of Churches training...
