

From Monday June 1:

Places of worship can open for private worship or small religious ceremonies for up to 20.

50 people can attend a funeral in addition to the celebrant and funeral staff,

In all cases, the following requirements will still apply:

- Distancing of at least 1.5m between attendees
- A register of attendees, including name, phone number, date & time of attendance
- A reasonable time between events to allow for cleaning between each service
- Cleaning by wiping with disinfectant:
