Key Quote from Fratelli Tutti (Pope Francis, 4-10-2020) Economic Privilege and Social Safety Nets

Some people are born into economic stable families, receive a fine education, grow up well nourished, or naturally possess great talent. They will certainly not need a proactive state; they need only claim their freedom.
