The memorial of St Martha was already celebrated on 29th July, a week after the feast of St Mary Magdalene because of the old and probably erroneous tradition that Mary the Magdalene to whom Christ appeared after his resurrection, was also Martha's sister, the penitent whose sins the Lord had forgiven.

SECOND SUNDAY OF ST JOSEPH

His sorrow when he saw Jesus born in poverty; his joy when the angels announce Jesus' birth.
