# **Praying th Rosary in May**

Pope Francis is urging Catholics to pray the Rosary through the month of May for an end to the COVID-19 pandemic. To date, more than 3 million people have died from coronavirus, with many countries experiencing their worst wave yet. India is presently afflicted with over 300,000 daily new infections.

Each day this month, the rosary will be broadcast from one of thirty Marian Shrines from across the world. St Mary's Cathedral in Sydney will represent the Church in Australia. The daily rosary will be broadcast live at 6pm Rome time — that's 2am our time. You don't have to interrupt your sleep to join the Holy Father's prayer campaign. Pray a daily Rosary at a time of your own choosing.
