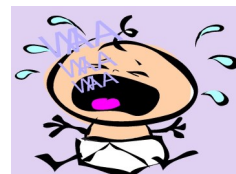
A Prayer for the Farming Community

COVID UPDATE– Volunteers needed

The Victorian Government announced that religious ceremonies can occur with a density quotient of 1 person per 2 sqm when using a COVID Check-in Marshal, otherwise density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm .

Currently we have a max of 75 people for each church due to the 1 person per 4sqm, however if we can get a volunteer to act as a COVID Check-in Marshal– someone getting to mass early to ensure each person checks in via QR code or the manual system, then we can have max of 150 people attending mass.
