MASS RETURNS THIS WEEKEND: We rejoice that at long last we can return to our regular weekend Mass schedule on this final weekend of October rather than waiting till November as previously anticipated.

PROOF OF VACCINATION STATUS REQUIRED WHEN NUMBERS 30+: Thank you to all who've emailed your Vaccination Certificate to our Parish Office or shown this to Fr John. This only needs doing once.

30 PERSON LIMIT WITHOUT VACCINATION: When status is unknown or unvaccinated, our limit is 30 persons. This means weekday Masses can continue as normal without Vaccination Certificates and these will only be required for Saturday/Sunday Masses at St Augustine's.

AVOCA, DUNOLLY AND BEALIBA MASSES: Unless numbers unexpectedly jump above 30, Proof of Vaccination won't be required.

MASKS AND CHECKING IN: As per shops, cafes, etc, masks and checking in (via QR code or manual recording) continue to be required inside churches and other public buildings.
