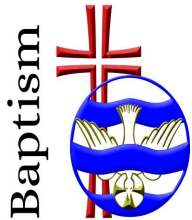

Catholics across Australia are invited to participate in a period of local consultation for the next international Synod of Bishops, which has the theme: **"For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission"**.

Pope Francis invites the entire Church to reflect on this theme that is decisive for the Church's life and mission: *"It is precisely this path of synodality (walking together) which God expects of the Church of the third millennium. Synodality starts with hearing from the whole People of God. A Church that teaches must be firstly a Church that listens."*

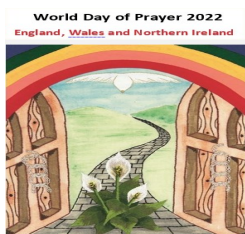
