only a phone call and everything is fixed up.

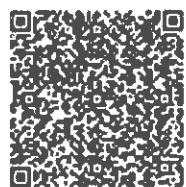
But when you have no friends,

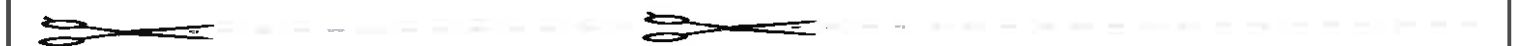
