St Patrick's Cathedral Parish, Liturgy Committee, would like to invite your parishioners to the Colloquium "**Sing Assembly Sing**" which will be held on Saturday 8th October, from 10.00 am - 4.00 pm. in St Patrick's Cathedral Hall.

This day is bringing to our Diocese expert presenters Rev Dr Kevin Lenehan, Dr Paul Taylor and Ms Sophy Morley for a colloquium open to all parishes across the Diocese. The subject for the day is the important role played by the Assembly (Congregation), particularly in the area of music. If the Assembly is not participating in the liturgical music, then the music may not be achieving its objective. This day aims to guide those preparing Liturgy in gaining knowledge and understanding in order to assist the engagement of the Assembly. As well as keynote presenters there will be a number of workshops offered.
