CONCLUDING RITE

With closing prayer and a blessing, the Liturgy concludes in silence.

- Leader: O saviour God, your Son was nailed to the cross Stand so that we might enjoy everlasting life with you: May we see through the pain and suffering of our own lives, to the glory of salvation that your son won for us. We pray through Jesus Christ.
- All: Amen.

All depart in silence.
