Chaplain opportunity

Your Dream School Programs are a registered School Chaplaincy Service Provider, and we provide services to Australian schools that aim to help young people overcome life challenges and live their dreams. As mentioned, a nearby school is currently seeking a Chaplain worker and I would love to extend this opportunity to the congregation of nearby churches.

A little about the role:

A school chaplain provides wellbeing support to students commonly done through 1:1 mentorship and/or small group programs, such as lunch time activities, breakfast clubs or wellbeing programs. Chaplains are also commonly involved in engaging with the wider school community such as staff and families.

The role is a casual position roughly 2-3 days a week and requires some basic documents such as a current Working with Childrens Check, National Police Clearance, and a minimum of certificate 4 in community service or equivalent.
