THE SEASON OF CHRISTMAS: This varies in length depending on what day of the week Christmas Day occurs. The Christmas season concludes with the Feast of the Baptism of Our Lord, which is usually on the Sunday after the Feast of the Epiphany that celebrates Jesus' being revealed to the pagan world in the persons of the Magi (the 3 kings). However, there can be a clash in the calendar. In some countries, Epiphany is a Holy Day of Obligation, in which case it is kept on its proper date, January 6 (the twelfth day of Christmas). In other countries, including Australia, it is celebrated on the Sunday following New Year's Day. However, if the Sunday after New Year (and this includes this year) falls on January 7 or 8, calendars could end up out of plumb. Some would be celebrating the last day of Christmas time when others would have begun Ordinary Time. To overcome this, when the Epiphany is celebrated on January 7 or January 8, the Baptism of Our Lord is kept the following day which this year is on Monday 8th January.
