**Star of the Sea Parish - South West Coast:**

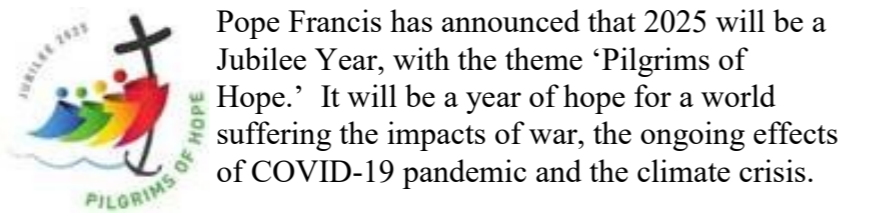
Fr Abraham Thomas will move from his role as Assistant Priest here at Star of the Sea Parish to be the Assistant Priest in the Cathedral Parish.
