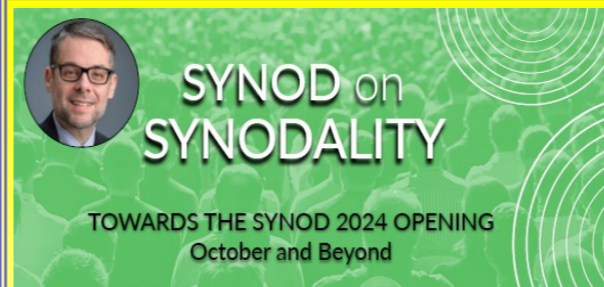

Published on 9 July 2024, the *Instrumentum Laboris* (Working Document) for the second Assembly of the Synod in October 2024 sets the tone and expectations for the Assembly.
A key question for Catholics is: *Will it be enough to restore credibility and confidence in an ailing church and reverse the rapidly declining engagement with Mass and the sacraments?*

Catholics across the globe have expressed their concerns and desires in copious submissions over the past six years. *Will those heart-felt expressions be heard and acted on?*

Continuing the pattern of moderated conversations in table groups, the outcomes of this gathering will, in effect, be a test of the synodal process and the quality of Catholic leadership.

Massimo Faggioli and John Warhurst will discuss these questions, the upcoming Synod, and the future beyond the Synod. A Question & Answer session will follow.
